

Sheep & Goat Research Journal Guidelines for Authors

The *Sheep & Goat Research Journal* is an on-line publication of the American Sheep Industry Association, Inc.

Manuscript Submission and Copyright Release forms (available on-line) will be required for all manuscripts that are submitted. The Journal is accessible on-line at www.sheepusa.org.

Objective

The aim of the *Sheep & Goat Research Journal* is to provide and publish electronically timely sheep and goat research findings that can be used by scientists, educators, extension agents, and producers. Specifically, the Journal aims to encourage producer use of research that has practical application.

Editorial Policy

The *Sheep & Goat Research Journal* publishes articles of research relating to all aspects of sheep and goat production, including marketing. Articles should relate and contribute to the advancement of the American sheep and goat industries and/or their products. All research articles must represent unpublished, original research and conclusions reached must be supported by research results. Articles that promote commercial products and services will not be approved for publication. Articles that promote practical applied research are encouraged. The submission of review articles is accepted and will be subject to the same review process as other submitted articles. All manuscripts and correspondence should be addressed to:

Inquiries or questions may be directed to Dr. Stewart via email or telephone.

1. Manuscripts must be provided in Microsoft Word.
2. One printed copy of the manuscript and all charts, illustrations and tables should be surface mailed to Dr. Stewart, along with the Manuscript Submission and signed Copyright Release form.
3. Electronic files of the manuscript and any available charts, illustrations and tables **also** should be sent as attachments to Dr. Stewart's email address. If you do not have electronic files of charts, illustrations or tables, we will utilize your printed, surface-mailed materials.

Review Process

Manuscripts are subject to critical review by an editorial board or others designated by the editor. Authors will be notified by email of acceptance or rejection of papers. Manuscripts needing substantial revision will be returned to authors via email and must be revised and returned by an indicated deadline. Corrected manuscripts may be returned via email. Papers not suitable for publication will be returned to the authors with an explanation of the rejection.

Manuscript Submission

One copy of the manuscript to be considered should be mailed (hard copy) to Dr. Whit Stewart at the address to the left, along with the Manuscript Submission and signed Copyright Release form. Include a cover letter from the main corresponding author with mailing address, email address, telephone, and fax numbers. Additionally, you must email files of the manuscript and graphics to Dr. Inskeep's email address. It is the intent of the editor that the review process will be handled electronically with reviewers, as well as the corresponding author. As a style reference, authors may refer to the *Journal of Animal Science* Instructions to Authors (Revised 2019.) Every effort is made to publish papers promptly. Papers are posted to the Journal as soon as they are through the review process. Normally a paper is published approximately six months following the receipt from author(s).

Format

Manuscripts must be typed and double-spaced in Microsoft Word using either Helvetica or Times Roman font. The lines on all pages, including those pages for Literature Cited and Figure Legends, must be numbered in the left margin beginning with the numeral one (1) at the top of the page. Submission of excessive tabular data is discouraged: tables should be limited to data that supports and is essential to clarifying research findings. Tables must be typed, double-spaced and on an individual sheet. All figures used in the text must be provided camera-ready and electronically, if possible. If camera-ready-figure preparation is required, the author will be billed at an hourly rate of \$60 per hour.

The following format should be used when submitting research manuscripts.

1st	Summary (250 words or less)
2nd	Key words (up to six)
3rd	Introduction
4th	Materials and Methods
5th	Results and Discussion
6th	Conclusion
7th	Literature Cited

When citing literature in the text, use both authors if there are only two. If there are more than two, use the first author and "et al."

Proofing

The primary author will receive galley proofs electronically, in pdf format, for review. Any changes should be sent in a list via email to the editor by the deadline indicated. Failure to return in a timely manner will delay article publication.

Charge

The publication charge for the *Sheep & Goat Research Journal* is \$60 per page, plus an additional charge for color. Position announcements are \$30 per quarter page or less. Authors will be billed when final proofs are accepted.
