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Why Export Programs

Domestically – the U.S. textile industry uses - 30-40% of U.S. annual wool production

Military – 10-20%

Hosiery

Woolen industry

We wish that as in 1995 and before, most American wool was used in the U.S.

International textile industry used -- 55% of U.S. annual wool production

Over last 20 years exports have ranged from 55 to 85% of annual U.S. production

Of export was 75% was grease wool, other is scoured, top, noils etc.



ASI PROGRAMS with USDA Foreign Ag Service (FAS)

- Marketing trade advertising, social media
- Connection through tours to the United States (Reverse Trade Missions)
- Send exporters overseas
- Assist sending samples of U.S. wool to new customers or for new uses.
- Processing trials
- Joint Programs with International Wool Textile Organization (IWTO)



EXPORTS 2020-21

(Oct. 1, 2020 – Sept 30, 2021)

- Increase in exports
 - More countries
 - Weight Increased 62%
 - to 6.3 millions pounds clean (from 3.9million pounds clean)
 - Value increased 75%
 - To \$16.2 million (from \$9.2 million)
 - Better prices, demand on higher quality wools



Challenges this past year

Demand steep decline in 2020

Has come back to pre-pandemic prices

But we have some inventory to move

Quality and fine wools easier to move
