
### Country Freedom based on WOAH guidance

- No scrapie cases for 7 years (last U.S. case Jan. 2021)
- Surveillance needs to have appropriate geographical distribution
- Country must have import controls to prevent reintroduction of scrapie


## Scrapie Eradication: So close but not quite......

## Keys to Eradication:

### Traceability and Surveillance

# The last two scrapie traces could not be traced from slaughter to flock-of-origin.



#### **Slaughter Positives –**

- IN goat July 2019, 2 possible herds of origin tested and monitored with no additional cases found
- WI blackface sheep, traced back to AR -January 2021, flock-of-origin couldn't be traced through market


# States must collect more than their minimums to achieve the National Target of > 40,000

If every state just met its minimum numbers, the total would only be 15,629!




### Number of Animals Sampled by Fiscal Year






### FY 2024 Surveillance

Surveillance Strategy Concentration Points

- Partner with States and Industry to:
  - ➤ Increase RSSS federal, state and custom sites and number of samples collected at each site
  - Increase samples collected at other sites such as terminal feedlots, auction markets, U Kills, Dealer Lots, etc.




## Surveillance Strategy On-farm



- Increase live and dead animal sampling and clinical suspect reporting:
  - Producers
  - Veterinarians don't forget small animal practices! May see pet goats.
  - Extension agents
  - Ag colleges and universities
  - Labs rabies negatives, necropsy submissions
